Must for the RPET Examination:

1. Candidate must report to COEPTECH University campus at 10.00 a.m. at the respective venues.
2. Candidate should carry a valid identify card (Aadhar card) with him/her and copy of Application form.

Instructions to be followed by Candidates:

1. Candidates are appealed to take the MOCK test at-least once before attempting actual online examination.
2. It is expected that every Candidate has taken the Mock Test at least once, and figured any technical issues that exist at their end, must be solved before the actual Exam. The Candidate should attempt it many times to ensure that there are no technical problems at their end. In case of any issue, related with Moodle, please contact Prof. Abhijit (9422308125)
3. After the Candidate starts the examination, it will end automatically after the stipulated time elapses provided the Candidate must be logged in to the exam system during the time elapses.
4. Candidate needs to complete the exam in mentioned time only. Extension in time beyond the stipulated time is not allowed.
5. While attempting the examination, no other application or webpage should be opened except provided exam software. Switching, minimizing or closing the exam window is not allowed during the exam.
6. The answer to a question gets saved, when you move to the next question. Answer to last question will be saved if you click on "Finish Attempt".
7. Some problems like screen freeze are already known, it probably happens due to java script bugs or incomplete load of pages. The candidate has to simply reload the page or close the browser and restart. Exam always resumes from where it was.(No additional time will be given on account of this.)
8. If you choose, to click on "Finish Attempt", then note that on next screen you have to press on "Submit all and finish" and only then you can Manually submit the exam. You can actually click on "Return to attempt" from the page you get after clicking "Finish Attempt". (Again note that when time is over, the exam will get submitted automatically).

9. University in its sole discretion may disqualify the candidate if the candidate fails to follow the examination instructions or causes a breach in the terms and conditions of Online Exam or has supplied false or incorrect or incomplete information, or for any other reason the Institute finds appropriate.
10. University reserves all rights to change any above-mentioned rules and regulations at any stage during the entire process.
11. If due to any reason, the computer shuts down or the exam window gets closed, candidate can re-login and can continue with the exams.
