Dr. Mahesh Shindikar, Head of Department of Applied Sciences and Humanities, Dr. Mrunalini Phalak, Head, Department of Physics and faculty from all departments were instrumental in this activity. On special request, the Dr. (Capt.) C. M. Chitale, the Academic Council member also attended this meeting. The meeting was also attended by the members of STSM Council.

#### Points Discussed in Meeting: -

**Item no. a)** Dr. Shweta Chaure presented the structure and tentative syllabus for Minor course in Japanese language that aims at providing language proficiency until Level 1 & 2.

**Item no. b)** Dr. Rahul Magar (a resource person), from the Department of History, SPPU presented the structure and tentative syllabus for **Minor course in History** which was designed keeping in mind the engineering orientation, with research project in the final semester to give a hand-on experience to students. Dr. Meshram advised for a change in the same highlighting the issue with the use of the term "technology" and asked to have it edited and redrafted.

Dr. Kshipra Moghe presented the structure and tentative syllabus for **Minor course in Industrial and Applied Psychology,** which is an extended and advanced version of the existing elective course, with research project in the final semester to give a hand-on experience to students.

Dr. Meshram highlighted that approval for the AEDP needs to be ratified again, (BFSI and Supply chain management) since it wasn't documented in the previous minutes of the Academic Council. This was approved immediately by the council members.

# <u>With reference to Item c) Department of Management Studies presented Minor subjects</u> <u>in 5<sup>th</sup> School Council meeting.</u>

<u>Item no. C</u>)- i) Mr Kanad Deshmukh Presented BFSI Minor to the school council. He presented the importance of BFSI subject, Rational of the subject along with Program Outcome.

Course Structure is discussed in a meeting where it's spread across the 4 semesters from Semester IV to VII.

Later sir discussed about each subject's key concepts and enlightened all council members regarding objective behind considering the same. He also discussed about minor project, which is included in semester VII, to link subject with either Industry or research.

After presenting the subject, the platform was open for discussion. Dr. Chitale suggested including "Connected Banking" which is current trend in market will add value to Minor subject. This suggestion was welcome and will be incorporated into the subject for the next Council Meeting.

The rest of all suggestions presented were accepted without any modification.

Dr. Arun Mudbidri; seconded the point.

<u>Item no. C</u>)- ii) Mrs. Sunita Bangal Presented SCM Minor to the school council. She presented the importance of SCM subject, Rational of the subject along with Program Outcome.

Course Structure is discussed in a meeting where it's spread across the 4 semesters from Semester IV to VII.

Later ma'am discussed each subject's key concepts and enlightened all council members regarding the objective behind considering the same. She also discussed a minor project, which is included in semester VII, to link the subject with either Industry or research. Outcome of minor project will be either research papers or Case study or White Paper.

After presenting the subject, the platform was open for discussion. Dr. Chitale accepted all as it is. Dr.Alok Kumar suggested to include element of "Operations" which will strengthen the course. This suggestion will be incorporated in the presentation at the Academic council meeting.

Dr. Arun Mudbidri; seconded the point.

# It was unanimously recommended to start the same and was further sent to Academic council for consideration.

Item no. d) - Ratification of AEDP-BBA in BFSI and BBA in Supply Chain Management

Dr. Sandeep Meshram suggested that the AEDP program which was approved by the school council earlier be ratified again.

The council ratified the AEDP without any further suggestions

- b) One credit subject to be assessed Internally with NO END TERM Examination.

Dr. Arun Mudbidri initiated discussion under item e)-i any other points with permission of council, one point is regarding 1 credit course assessment. This assessment will be at the discretion of the faculty member and methods could be field study, presentation, case study whichever is suitable to subject.

The school council accepted the point without any suggestion.

Dr. Arun sir initiated second point under item e)-ii regarding academic calendar change as per requirements of instructional days defined by UGC. School Council accepted the suggestions and permitted to accommodate change not diverting main academic calendar.

Dr. Sandeep Meshram seconded the point.

#### Context-

Management is a different stream of the education and is mostly through group discussions, seminars, live projects & live Case histories with Industry Association thus making our students of MBA employable.

#### **Recommendations**-

1.Seperate academic calendar for FYMBA24-25 batch is unanimously recommended for implementation.

#### 2.Credit system----

In view of this the school council strongly recommends that there should be a separate **Academic Calendar** & a separate **Credit System** which needs to be followed for management studies.

- a) 1 Credit = 15 hours of face-to-face contact sessions including assessment as per COEP Technological University norms: not exceeding 2 hours.
- b) 1 Credit = 30 hours of Laboratory or Practical hours
- c) 1 credit = 60 hours of Internship/ Project/ Dissertation
- d) For courses which employ combination of practical and theory, the practical hour be converted to contact hours in the ratio of 1:2 meaning 1 face to face contact hour = 2 hours of Practical (Lab)

#### Suggestions/ Feedback from the Members of School Council

- Dr. Chitale highly appreciated all the presentations and suggested to include specific topics such as Johari Window for self-assessment in the Industrial and Applied Psychology course. He also agreed to the request to have additional faculty on board to manage this course given its vast scope through the four semesters.
- Milind Kulkarni and Dr. Chitale suggested that in the History course the syllabus must include topics that are included in the UPSC syllabus, as this will help students prepare later, if interested.
- Dr. Chitale also suggested to consider starting courses/programs in civil services to which he offered help and networking, whenever necessary.

All these points were duly acknowledged and effectively taken into consideration by the Dean, STSM and the heads of the departments of STSM. All the experts of School Council were highly impressed with the structure and syllabus of all minor courses being offered and appreciated the meticulous efforts taken by the faculty to make the courses unique and comprehensive as it attains the philosophy of NEP.

Dr. Meshram expressed a deep sense of gratitude to all the members of School Council for their scholarly suggestions. He extended sincere thanks to the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of COEP Tech for his guidance and visionary leadership along with other functionaries of COEP Tech. He thanked all the faculty colleagues of STSM for their cooperation and diligent efforts to make the curriculum NEP oriented in considerably short duration of time.

Other points were discussed by the council and Dr. Chitale suggested BA (Civil Services) where COEP technological University can think about introducing in the coming school council meeting.

Dr. Chitale also discussed Admission and CET related processes. Those suggestions will be under consideration. During the deliberations of School Council meeting Capt. C. M. Chitale, Hon'ble Member, pointed out that we should not compare MBA with Engineering. There must be some different thought process for MBA Specialization.
